

Russia's Stands on Ukraine's Crisis


In the war between Russia vs. Ukraine, Russia does not want the eastward expansion of NATO, including Finland. Russia desires Ukraine to be neutral and under its influence. Russia wants common security guarantees not only in Ukraine but also in pulling NATO forces from Poland, and Baltic countries - Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania. The president of Russia justified the Ukraine crisis on the ground of security interests and the rights of ethnic Russians. Presently, Russia wants assurance that in the future, Ukraine will never be allowed to join NATO and the West. Ukraine is free to choose its security alliances as a sovereign nation.



Latest Development

Russia launched a full-fledged invasion of Ukraine on February 24, 2022, and currently according to Russia, it has launched a "special military operation" to de-militarise Ukraine. Russia stated that the eastward expansion of NATO and Ukraine's desire to join NATO is a reason for the deployment of troops on the borders to protect its security considerations. Russia, on its borders with Ukraine, shall not be introduced into NATO into US. The war between Russia and Ukraine resulted in tensions between the west, the supportive nation of Ukraine, and Russia.



Impact on India's Economy

India has adopted the strategic autonomy approach to maximize its policy space like priority to National interest over the block politics held by India in getting discounted oil, fertilizer, and other commodities from Russia. As the war looms large, its effect is seen in the financial sector as due to the rise in the price of crude oil, inflation, and monetary policy of USA's Federal Bank, India's Forex Reserve has declined to 570 billion dollars is about 10%, the prices of natural gas have increased over 50%, there are crises of fertilizer availability. War and sanctions on Russia will hurt India's diamond and supply chain issues in the semiconductor industry.



Reason's behind Russo-Ukraine Conflict

The main reason behind the Russia-Ukraine conflict on why Russia and Ukraine are fighting is because Ukraine acceded to NATO, which would go against Russia's wishes and continue to endanger its security. The west, according to Russia, should guarantee that Ukraine will never get permission to be part of NATO. Ukraine has a large population, and it has substantial natural minerals and resources which also produce wheat, and vegetable oil, which are supposed to play an important role.

Impact on Economy

Ukraine's GDP was \$155.5 billion USD at the end of 2020, while Russia's GDP stood at \$148 trillion. The annexation of Crimea in 2014 coupled with plummeting oil prices in 2014–2015 cut Ukraine's GDP by over 50% from its all-time high in just two years. Though Russia's economy is about ten times larger than Ukraine's in terms of GDP, Ukraine's GDP grew 70.8% from 2015 to 2020 while Russia's advanced only 8.8%. In that same time frame, both economies have progressed in near-perfect correlation since 1989.



Russo-Ukrainian War

Russia-Ukraine war is a major conflict we have witnessed from February, 2022. Russia is invaded in Ukraine and it has become the most significant conventional attack on a country that caused a huge economic crisis of the whole world. Conflict occurs when disagreement arises between groups, communities and countries. where is a risk to their needs, interests, etc. This is a condition in which people receive a threat such as physical, emotional, political and so on. War frenzy is traditional, if a spark is raised, thousands of winds are presented to blow it, even when there is only war between two nations, the whole world sits into two parts and supports one side.

Russia-Ukraine war has a major impact in India. In this whole conflict situation India has taken a neutral position, because choosing a side is a loss-loss situation for India. Russia has been a long term ally to India, & 50% of our weapons come from Russia. Another side is US with whom we have just started developing friendly ties. We are making new alliances through QUAD. Russia is the largest producer of crude oil too. Due to war there will be sanctions in Russia and the price of fuel will increase. Hence we will have to use fuel wisely. Rise in fuel price means rise in inflation, transports will be costly and stock market will be volatile for some moments. Crypto will be impacted as well. It does not matter who wins but we don't want to suffer from such external wars. Whatever be the cause of war, but the result is always the same, thousands of wars are known to push a nation back.
